Man arrested for multiple commercial burglaries



On 12/03/2017 at approximately 0900 hours, the Shelton Police Department arrested 47 year old Mark Lindsey of Stratford Ct. Lindsey was charged with three counts of Burglary 3rd Degree, Criminal Mischief 3rd Degree, Criminal Attempt at Larceny 3rd Degree and Larceny 5th Degree. Lindsey was held on a 25,000.00 bond and is scheduled to appear in Derby Superior court on 12/04/2017.

The arrest stems from a joint investigation with Stratford, Fairfield, Trumbull and Shelton Police Departments. The Stratford Police Department developed Lindsey as a burglary suspect in multiple Fairfield county towns. A Stratford Detective was conducting surveillance on Lindsey in the early morning hours of 12/03/2017. During the investigation Lindsey was caught in the act of burglarizing the Family Health Care building located at 330 Bridgeport Ave in Shelton. It was also learned that Lindsey was responsible for burglaries at office buildings at 680 and 1077 Bridgeport Ave during the early morning hours.

The investigation is still open and additional arrests are expected in the case.
