PRESS RELEASE Man pulls gun on neighbor while intoxicated

On 04/10/2017, the Shelton Police Department arrested 58 year old Mario Williams of Roberts Street Shelton. Williams was charged with Reckless Endangerment 1st degree, Threatening 2nd degree, Breach of Peace and Carrying a Firearm under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs. Williams was given a Derby Superior court date of 04/24/2017 and released on a \$2,500.00 bond.

The arrest stems from an incident were the Shelton Police were called to the Wooster Street Market for a report of a dispute at the store. It was reported that one of the men involved in the dispute brandished a firearm. Upon arrival officers spoke with the complainant who stated him and his ex-neighbor, Williams, had been



arguing over neighborhood issues. The complainant stated that Williams pulled a firearm and pointed it at him during the dispute. Williams, who was still scene, had a handgun in his possession and was discovered to be under the influence.

The charges in the press release are merely accusations, and the defendant is presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
