Man pulls gun on neighbor while intoxicated

On 04/10/2017, the Shelton Police Department arrested 58 year old Mario Williams of Roberts Street Shelton. Williams was charged with Reckless Endangerment 1st degree, Threatening 2nd degree, Breach of Peace and Carrying a Firearm under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs. Williams was given a Derby Superior court date of 04/24/2017 and released on a \$2,500.00 bond.

The arrest stems from an incident where the Shelton Police were called to the Wooster Street Market for a report of a dispute at the store. It was reported that one of the men involved in the dispute brandished a firearm. Upon arrival officers spoke with the complainant who stated him and his ex-neighbor, Williams, had been arguing over neighborhood issues. The complainant stated that Williams pulled a firearm and pointed it at him during the dispute. Williams, who was still scene, had a handgun in his possession and was discovered to be under the influence.
