Attempted carjacking, car burglary and stolen car leads to 4 arrests



On 05/31/2018 at approximately 9:00 PM a woman and her 13 year old daughter were parked in the Community Center parking lot on Huntington Street in Shelton. The woman got out of her vehicle to mail a letter and a green Subaru approached her. A male got out of the Subaru and demanded the woman's keys and pushed her to the ground. As the woman fell to the ground, her 13 year old daughter began to scream and the man retreated to the Subaru and fled the scene. A short time later the Shelton Police received a report of a vehicle burglary on Fern Drive with a green Subaru fleeing the scene. A BOLO was sent out to surrounding towns regarding the incident. A short time later the Trumbull Police Department located the Subaru

which crashed on White Plains Road and one of the occupants was taken into custody. Three other occupants fled on foot. The Subaru was discovered stolen out of Bridgeport. Shelton, Trumbull, Stratford and Bridgeport police canvassed the area for the three fleeing suspects. The three men were located and taken into custody a short time later.

The four were taken to the Shelton Police Department. 18 year old Antone Grant-Chalmers of Stratford, a 16 year old juvenile from Bridgeport and a 16 year old and 17 year old juvenile from Stratford were charged with Robbery 2nd Aided by Another, Robbery by Carjacking, Assault 3rd Degree, Criminal Attempt/Assault 3rd Degree, Reckless Endangerment 2nd Degree, Larceny 3rd Degree, Criminal attempt/Larceny 3rd Degree, Burglary 3rd Degree, Criminal Mischief 3rd degree and Conspiracy to Commit/Criminal Mischief 3rd Degree. The three juveniles were given juvenile summonses and released to their parents. Grant-Chalmers was held on a \$25,000 bond and given a Derby Superior court date of 06/01/2018.
