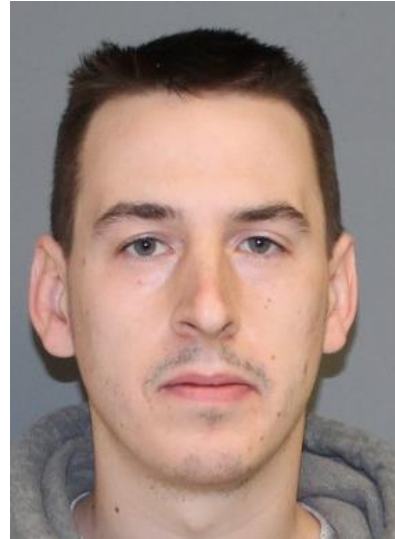

### Shelton Police Arrest Barricaded Man

On 02/01/2018 at approximately 1245 hours, the Shelton Police Department received a 911 call requesting a welfare check on Tyler Johnson. The concerned caller stated that Johnson claimed he was in possession of a gun. Johnson, who was known to Shelton officers, had multiple active arrest warrants from other area towns.

Officers responded to 77 Long Hill Ave and made phone contact with Johnson. Johnson denied being in the house and kept giving police different locations of where he was located. Shelton Police and other agencies were sent to various locations while officers surrounded the house. Police and detectives were able to determine that Johnson was inside the residence. Detectives also received information that Johnson planned to commit suicide by cop.



The Southwest Region 2 SRT team responded and staged directly in front of Johnson's house. Once the SRT was on scene, Detective Christopher Nugent was able to persuade Johnson to surrender and he came out peacefully. Nobody was injured during this incident.

28 year old Tyler Johnson of Shelton was charged with Breach of Peace 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree and Interfering with an Officer. Johnson was given a Derby Superior Court date of 02/16/2018 and will be transferred placed in custody by the other police departments that hold warrants for him.
