Shelton Police Arrest Man on Warrants Arriving by Bus

On 07/09/2018 Shelton Police arrested Fredrick Kushpinsky age 49, of Shelton on three outstanding warrants for Failure to Appear in Court and on an outstanding arrest warrant for eight (8) counts of violation of a protective order.

Shelton Police were contacted in June that Kushpinsky was attempting to make contact with a victim from a previous domestic violence arrest. During the course of the investigation it was discovered that Kushpinsky was sending mail while incarcerated on domestic related charges from Bridgeport Correctional Facility attempting to make contact with a victim

Kushpinsky had three outstanding warrants for missing court on other arrests. Shelton Police applied for and were granted an arrest warrant for Kushpinsky in this incident for eight counts of violating a protective order.

Shelton Police were contacted and informed that Kushpinsky would be arriving from out of town in Waterbury by Greyhound bus on 07/09/2018. Shelton Police with the assistance of Waterbury Police were able to locate Kushpinsky arriving at the bus terminal and take him into custody without incident.



Kushpinsky was transported to Shelton Police Department, where he was processed on the three Failure to appear warrants and the Shelton arrest warrant for eight counts of Violation of a Protective Order

Kushpinsky was held on \$225,000.00 bond for the three Failure to appear warrants and \$75,000.00 for the Shelton Investigation. Kushpinsky is scheduled to appear in Derby Superior Court on 07/10/2018.
