Firearm Stolen from Vehicle leads to Arrest

On 10/15/2020 the Shelton Police department arrested 37 Jerry Edouard of Shelton. The arrest stems from a complaint the police department received on 09/26/2020 regarding a vehicle burglary in the parking lot of a downtown restaurant. Several items were stolen from the vehicle including a semi-automatic firearm and several loaded magazines.

The Detective Bureau investigated the incident and secured a search and seizure warrant for Edouard's Shelton residence. Upon executing the warrant they discovered items stolen from the vehicle including the firearm and magazines.

Edouard was charged with Burglary 3rd Degree, Larceny 5th Degree, Theft of a Firearm, Criminal Possession of a Firearm and Criminal Possession of a High Capacity magazine. Edouard was held on a \$50,000 bond and will be arraigned in Milford Superior court on 10/16/2020.



The charges in the press release are merely accusations, and the defendant is presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty
